# WHO IS TONY PITCOCK?

My name is Tony Pitcock. I am a motorcycle racer from Hopewell, Virginia. I am writing to your company about a potential sponsorship for my 2025 season.

I got involved with racing when I was five years old. I got a motorcycle and started going to races with my Dad, who also raced. I have faced a lot of adversity over the years, but that hasn't stopped me from getting back on the bike and plugging away. In 1994, I was involved in an industrial fire at work which burned 80 percent of my body. In 2011, I crushed my pelvis in a racing accident. In 2015, I had a very serious spinal cord injury while training and suffered 34 total broken bones. In the last few years I was able to get comfortable on the bike again and adapt to a different way of training and racing. I also attended shows and events with the Virginia Spinal Association to help get the word out about how people can overcome adversity and live a normal life. My motorcycle is different than others and I want everyone to see how I can still ride being paralyzed.

## Plans for 2025

To continue to spread the word and tell people about The Bike Experience U.S.A and our new charity Ride Again that focuses on getting disabled riders back on the racetrack in a controlled and safe environment.

I will be racing with ASRA doing select rounds of the 2 HR Endurance Race Series with a few of my teammates as well as several rounds of the Sprint Race Series on the east coast including the series finale at Daytona International Speedway. We also plan to race as many WERA National Endurance rounds when the schedule allows if not all.

## 2024 Results

After a 3 month hospital stay early in the season for Spinal Cord related illness I was limited to 3 rounds so far this year with the 4th and final round at Daytona International Speedway in mid October! I was able to get on the podium multiple times in all but the first round.

I am still actively involved in my community doing a few bike shows a year to showcase my adaptive motorcycle and to spread the word about all the people that make this possible for me as a paraplegic motorcycle rider and racer.

I appreciate the consideration and I look forward to speaking with you some more about some ideas I have to represent your company.



